Objective:

Day 1 Program:

PSC1/ PS MER:

- Presentation of medical training: Emergency aid chain, Vital signs assessment
Handling illnesses/ medical emergencies, hypoglycemia, hemorrhages, choking, burns, spinal trauma, unconsciousness/ coma, drowning, hypothermia, and cardiac arrest management. Practical workshops and evaluation.

Day 2 and 3 Program:

- Safety briefing, maintenance of safety equipment
- Damage control, sail reduction, calming tactics, watch management
- Weather forecasting and use of onboard electronic tools
- Rough seas: Safety instructions, boat stability, skipper's role
- Towing and assisting another vessel
- Communication equipment, GMDSS equipment
- Triggering emergency services: Alert messages to CCMM and CROSS
- Man overboard: Training with mannequins using various recovery methods
- Real-life man overboard scenarios with survival gear during maneuvers
- Fire onboard: Use of fixed and portable extinguishers (Division 240 compliance)
- Liferaft training: Aquatic environment drills, capsizing, boarding, and survival
